



Conflict Minerals Policy of Detection Technology Group

Detection Technology understands the importance of responsible sourcing of conflict minerals. Any tin, tantalum, tungsten, or gold (called the 3TG's) contained in our product must not originate from rebel-held mines, which are funding armed conflict in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) region.

Accordingly, Detection Technology has adopted this Conflict Minerals Policy and expects its suppliers to meet the expectations set out below:

1. Supply "DRC Conflict Free" materials

Under Detection Technology's conflict minerals policy, suppliers are expected to supply materials that are "DRC conflict free," which means either:

- a. any 3TGs necessary to the functionality or production of supplied materials must not directly or indirectly fund armed conflict in the DRC or adjoining countries, or
- b. any 3TGs must be from recycled or scrap sources.

2. Adopt conflict minerals policies

Suppliers must adopt a policy regarding conflict minerals consistent with this policy, implement management systems to support compliance with their policy and require their suppliers to take the same steps.

3. Provide conflict minerals declarations

All key suppliers must provide to Detection Technology a completed conflict minerals declaration by using the RMI's Conflict Minerals Reporting Template. Suppliers are expected to send this request to their suppliers and successively upstream until the smelter/refiner is identified.
